Baldwin Congregational Church Cornelius Scholarship

Scholarships to graduating senior(s) who are part of Baldwin Congregational Church

Baldwin Rotary STRIVE Scholarship

Non-renewable scholarship(s) to graduating senior(s) from Baldwin High School

- Preference given to students participating in the STRIVE program
- Selection factors are to include academic achievement, superior personal character, leadership ability, and potential for future academic success

Brail Health Care Scholarship

Non-renewable scholarships to graduating seniors from Baldwin High School pursuing a career in health care

- Selection factors are to include academic achievement, superior personal character, leadership ability, and the potential for future academic success
- Scholarships may be given on a renewable basis, but preference should be given to applicants in the most recent graduating class of Baldwin High School

Charles Coykendall Scholarship

Non-renewable scholarship to a graduating senior from Baldwin High School

- Selection factors are to include academic achievement, superior personal character, leadership ability, and the potential for future academic success
- Scholarships may be given on a renewable basis, but preference should be given to applicants in the most recent graduating class of Baldwin High School

Gerl Foundation Scholarship

Non-renewable scholarships to graduating high school seniors from Baldwin High School. Students must demonstrate:

- Academic achievement
- Financial need
- Superior personal character
- Leadership ability
- Potential for future success

Martin Luther King Scholarship

Non-renewable scholarship to a graduating senior from Baldwin High School

Robert and Barbara Radunzel Family Scholarship

Non-renewable scholarship to a graduating senior from Baldwin High School. This scholarship shall be used at the College Bookstore only for books and/or course-required supplies. The following criteria were determined by donors (in order of preference):

- For one or more Baldwin High School seniors that have been accepted to attend West Shore Community College
- For a Baldwin High School graduate who is attending West Shore Community College for their second year with a 2.5 or better GPA
- For Baldwin High School seniors participating in the annual college readiness program in conjunction with Grand Valley State University or a similar college readiness program with another college or university

Wenger Scholarship
