How it works

- The Community Foundation has a variety of fund types available that provide flexibility for you to be as active as you wish. Funds may be named for family, loved ones, businesses, or you can choose to remain anonymous.
- Most endowed funds are established with a minimum contribution of \$10,000.
- If you would like to create a fund but a gift of \$10,000 is not realistic at this time, consider the Build-A-Fund program. This program allows you to build your fund over a five-year period.
- The Build-A-Fund program enables you to fulfill your charitable wishes in a manner reflective of your personal circumstances. Consider this option to create a lasting legacy by establishing a permanently endowed fund bearing a name that is meaningful to you.
- When the fund minimum is accumulated within the agreed upon time, the fund will become active and grants will be awarded according to the fund agreement.
