

Two new scholarship opportunities for local adults!



The Make Newaygo County Home Scholarship is intended for recent post-secondary graduates or returning professionals planning to live **and** work in Newaygo County or a Newaygo County school district.

- Awards will be a maximum of \$15,000 to be paid out on a quarterly basis over three years
- Awards can be used for student loan repayment, moving expenses, down payment on a home, or other expenses related to making Newaygo County home
- Applicants must be employed or have a legitimate offer to be employed

The Newaygo County Individual Training Scholarship is designed to assist adults in career and job training, not degree attainment.

- Awards will not exceed \$2,500 **and** employers must contribute at least 25% of training costs
- Training must be provided by a third party, not by the applicant's employer
- Some examples include:
 - Microsoft course at a community college
 - Roofing safety course
 - CAD course
 - Welding, electrical, or plumbing course
 - CNC machine training
 - CDL training
- Applicants from small to mid-size businesses are strongly encouraged to apply
- Available for applicants who reside and work in Newaygo County or a Newaygo County school district
